


MONTHLY REPORT JULY 2025

As I write this, we have just finished upgrading the Library's wifi. Now there are no dead zones, and speeds should be much faster. The process for logging in is the same, but the behind-the-scenes wiring and hardware is newer and better. On a personal note, I can now get wifi in my office, which is also a dead zone for data coverage. And the back of the Administration area is now covered as well.

The wifi is just one of the things that have changed recently. IVPL has gotten new LED lighting, which was installed not only to brighten up the Library, but also reduce energy costs. While it will take a year-to-year comparison to see how much we save, the increased brightness makes it great to see everything we have to offer.

The next major upgrade will be to our HVAC system. This project will begin in 2026 and, while I don't

It's cooler here—in more ways than one.







